255 UNITS = 609 PEOPLE



Major developments already built or planned in the near future (excluding New Monks Farm)

- 1,685 Units
- 4,028 People<sup>1</sup>
- 2,022 Cars<sup>2</sup>



Additional major developments that could potentially be realised within 5 yrs.

- 1,000 Units
- 2,289 People<sup>1</sup>
- 1,200 Cars<sup>2</sup>

## Health

- Each GP in Shoreham to look after an extra 150 patients (extra 94 in Lancing and Sompting)
- An extra 228 GP appointments per week in Shoreham (118 in Lancing and Sompting)
- 22.4% of patients in W Sussex are over 65 (17.6% nationally)
  meaning greater and more complex care
- Number of GPs in Shoreham 25 in 2020, 19.8 now
- GP funding would increase as the patient list does



## Education

#### Now

- Primaries expanded since 2012
- Secondaries now at capacity
- Local school not guaranteed
- What is WSCC's plan?

#### **Planned**

- 3,718 dwellings in local plan
- NO clarity on school provision
- Huge underestimation of children in new developments
- LA forecast 75 kids per 1,000 persons. Could be 230 313 kids per 1,000 persons
- Need 2 new primaries <u>and</u> one new secondary school

#### Broken system

#### **Adur District Council**

- Responsible for planning approval
- Have to hit housing targets regardless of INFRASTRUCTURE
- Generates demand, no responsibility to supply

#### **West Sussex County Council**

- Responsible for planning & provision of all <u>state</u> school places in West Sussex/Adur. CANNOT open new schools!
- Can only expand existing LA schools (& ask Academies)
- All the responsibility but little actual power
- New schools are Academies, Free Schools, Voluntary Aided or Trust Schools, lobbied by DoE
