Footpaths



West Sussex Footpaths and Public Rights of Way team are carrying out their periodic inspection of the local footpaths and rights of way during September, to plan and prioritise their work programme for the year ahead. You can find the map here. When you are out blackberrying or exploring at the start of the month please keep an eye out for parts of the network that are in need of repair or attention and report them using this link Report a problem with a Right of Way - West Sussex County Council. This will catch the attention of the inspection team to help them compile their list of jobs. The Greening Old Shoreham team are talking with the Council's Rangers about helping to keep the footpaths more accessible and improving connections between the Downs and the town.

Community Orchards

Brighton Permaculture Trust have asked about sites for a community orchard. It's a wonderful way to add to the green canopy, create habitat for pollinators, build community and supply food right where we live. And there are many green spaces in Old Shoreham that could be perfect for an orchard - on the riverbank, in verges, on the hillsides, in the park. Or could there be a 'linear orchard' along your street?
